Participate in an intense one-week course introducing forensic archaeology and crime scene processing methodologies. This is a Saint Mary's University course taking place in Toronto, Ontario. Students will learn crime scene protocols, clandestine burial recovery techniques, and evidence collection. Topics include: the roles of crime scene personnel, scene safety and ethics, evidence photography & documentation, establishing scene perimeters, crime scene surveying, gridding and mapping, and excavation techniques.
